Dear Parents and Carers of Reception, Years 1 and 2,

Key Stage 1 Sports Day

As you are aware Sports Day for Reception and KS1 will take place on Friday 1st July (reserve date – Friday 8th July). Children will be on the field ready to start by 9.30am and will be finished by midday. All parents, grandparents and younger children are welcome to come and lend their support. As there will be limited seating, you are welcome to bring your own chairs or blankets to sit on. The main aim of Sports Day is for children to have fun and to enjoy themselves. There will be a designated viewing area for parents - please stay within these areas in order for everyone to have a fun and safe sports day. We look forward to seeing you there.

Our Sport Day will follow the same format as last year. It will be split into track (races) and field events. The track events will take place on the KS2 field and field events on the KS1 field. All children will be put into their houses where they will compete to earn points for their house. Each class will go around together competing in the different events. Reception will start on the track whilst Year 1 and 2 will be competing in the field events. Then they will swap.

The events are as follows:

Field

Bean bag balance, around cones

Children balance a bean bag on their head whilst weaving in and out of cones.

Sack race

Children compete in a relay race using sacks.

Sponge race

Children transfer water from a large container full of water by soaking a sponge and squeezing the water out into a different container.

Bean bag throw

Children take it in turns to throw 3 beanbags for accuracy.

Obstacle race

Children will participate in an obstacle race – up, down, over, under, through!.

Over / Under Game

A relay game passing the ball over heads and under legs.

Track

Children will take part in a sprint race on the track competing against other children in their class. Stickers will be presented to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. There will be a Champion's Race for the fastest girls and boys in the year group as determined by pre-sports day sprint times. At the end of the Sports Day, a presentation will be made to children in the winning team.

Reminders:

Children should come to school wearing their usual PE kit including trainers or plimsolls along with a plain t-shirt, ideally this will be in their house colour (red, blue, yellow or green) or plain white. If it is a sunny day, please ensure your child has a sun hat and if you wish for your child to wear sun cream, please apply before school and bring a named water bottle.

House Teams:

Every effort has been made to keep children in the same house team as previous years (and keeping siblings in the same house where possible). Due to a historical imbalance of numbers in each house, it has been necessary to change a small number of children into a different house this year. We know this is not ideal, but it will hopefully make for a far better sports day with an even number of children in each house. Thank you for your understanding.
