2015/16 Fundraising Achievements

We are delighted to announce that, thanks to your incredible generosity, the Friends had another fantastic year.

The cake sales continue to be very popular, raising nearly £2,500 profit last year. While the Christmas Fair & Discos always prove to be incredibly successful, generating over £10,500 (almost £6,500 profit).

The Summer Circus & Mini Fair, generated over £11,000, adding over £7,000 profit to Friends' funds. Many of you will pleased to know that our full scale fair will return again in the summer!

We're planning new & exciting events for the coming year, and hope to raise even more funds to provide additional support to the school and help further our children's education.

Money For Nothing?

Are you interested in supporting our school but worried about time commitments, childcare and how exactly to get started? If you or your partner work, your employer may be able to help.

A number of organisations offer a range of support options for charities such as Cannon Lane Primary school.

Matched Funding is the most common; this is where an employer commits to match the funds raised at a particular event, allowing us to potentially double our fundraising. For example, one of our parents works for Thames Water, she has discovered that if we can identify another 2 parents with the same employer, funds raised at events like cake sales and summer & Christmas fairs can be matched by Thames Water.

If your organisation doesn't offer matched funding, there are other ways they could get involved, from event sponsorship to providing volunteers to help out. Did you know some employers even offer paid time off for their staff if they volunteer during their normal working hours?

So, what does this mean for you? As a parent or carer at our school we would urge you to ask if you or your partner's employer can provide any support for Cannon Lane Primary School. If you feel they can, please contact a member of the Friends Committee and we'd be delighted to explore this with you further.

Other Fundraising Ideas

If you don't have an employer who is able to support us, or you don't have the time to commit to volunteering with the Friends, you could still provide vital fundraising support, with very little effort.

EasyFundraising: You can raise funds for the school, just by shopping online as normal. It doesn't cost you a penny extra and you can make a big difference on everything from groceries to getaways. Greetings Cards: All the children will be participating in a greeting card design project in class. It aims to encourage pupils' creativity and design skills whilst also raising funds for our school. Your child's unique design will be brought home with an order form very soon, and the cards will then be professionally printed. We do hope you are able to support this project!

Gift Aid: The Friends are in the process of registering for Gift Aid, which allows us to claim back 25p for every £1 donated! This may mean we ask for a few extra details when donating over £20, but we will soon provide useful guides outlining what's required from you for us to reclaim this additional source of funding.

Fundraising Targets


The school has outlined its desire for the Friends to support it this year by providing a number of iPad tablets, suitable software and secure trolleys to charge and store them.

Each set of 32 iPads will provide an iPad for each child in one class, and these will be circulated throughout the school so that all the children will able to benefit from them.


