In working order – Toys need to be seen to be working, therefore we kindly request that you supply any necessary batteries (they need not be new).

In good condition – We would appreciate you cleaning any items if they look grubby. Please no books that are scribbled in or have ripped pages.

Please don't bring in all your second-hand toys regardless of their condition. We have a fantastic team running this stall and we only want to sell **good quality** items that you or your children would want to buy.
